But I ran out of beer. Let's go get some! 沒問題！但我家的啤酒喝完了。我們去買一些吧！ insight/out of sight insight 是指「洞察、深入見解」，是一種對事情有相當深刻的瞭解，進而發覺此事的深入見解。 out of sight 則是指「看不見」，並不是像視障者般地看不見，而是指某事物離開視線的意思。 而這也衍出了一個片語“out of sight, out of mind”，意思是「眼不見為淨，囉！ on/off 篇 put on/put off put on 可以指「穿上」，像是穿上衣服、鞋子、香水等等；而「做某次的動作」可以用 put on some perfume，或者 wear some perfume；若是形容「身上帶有香水的狀態」則是 wearing perfume 囉！ put on 同時也可以指「增加」，像是增加體重，就可用 put on some weight 來描述！ She's putting on some perfume. 她正在擦香水。 She wore some perfume on her wrist. 她手腕上擦了些香水。 She's wearing perfume. 她擦了香水。 I think I'm too skinny. I want to put on some weight. 我覺得我太瘦了，我想增重。 put off 則是指「推遲、拖延某事」。像是期末考快到了，你只好推遲跟同學的聚餐，趕快拯救期末考！ I'm afraid I'll have to put off our dinner party. We must save our final exam first! 我們恐怕要延後晚餐聚會了，得先拯救我們的期末考啊！再介紹給大家一個超實用經典名言！“Never put off till tomorrow what you can do today.” – Thomas Jefferson. 這句話就是傑佛遜所言之「今日事，今日畢」啦！ onset/offset onset 是指「事情的開端、前兆」，通常指不好的事情的開端，像是颱風來臨的前兆，或者經濟衰退的開端，都可以用 onset 來描述。 offset 則是指「補償、抵銷」，有種「為了先前的過錯而嘗試彌補」的意味。 Playing League of Legend three days before the final exam can be seen as an onset of being flunked! 期末考前三天還在打 LoL 可能是被當的前兆！ I need to get a better score on my finals in order to offset my poor midterm. 我期末要考好一點，才能抵銷之前考不好的期中考。 take on/take off take on 是指「接受」，通常是接受挑戰、責任。 take off 有四種意思，可以指「脫掉衣物」、「飛機起飛」、「休假」、「突然離去」，可以根據上下文判斷 take off 到底是哪種意思，小心不要搞混了囉！ In the movie Hunger Games, Katniss volunteered to take on the challenge as a tribute. 在電影《飢餓遊戲》裡，凱妮絲自願接受挑戰，成為貢品。 Why don't you take off your jacket before the plane takes off? 你何不在飛機起飛前把外套脫掉呢？ Lisa took a day off, and took off for the hospital. Lisa 請了一天假，然後匆匆離開，前往醫院。 on-screen/off-screen on-screen 是個很口語的用法，意指「在電視、電影裡」，或者「在大螢幕上」。 off-screen 則是 on-screen 的反義詞，指「在幕後」、「在螢光幕下」。 Jennifer Lawrence is always extremely mature and reliable on-screen. 珍妮佛勞倫斯在大螢幕上總是給人很成熟可靠的感覺。 Off-screen, on the contrast, she is a spirited, delightful lady with a great sense of humor. 相反地，螢光幕下的她則充滿活力、討喜又有幽默感。 up/down 篇 stand up/stand down stand up 有四個意思，可以單純指「起立」，也可以指「放棄人擔子」；如果加上 for，變成 stand up for，意思則是「為某人辯護、發聲」；而如果加上 to，變成 stand up to，則是指「面對、經得住」，像是面對現實世界、經得住困難等等。要小心不要搞混了囉！ stand down 則是指「退下」。通常在電影裡看到軍官士兵退下時，就會用 stand down 來描述囉！ Everybody, stand up! 通通有，起立！ I got stood up! 我被放鴿子了！ John stood up for his right. John 替自己的權利發聲。 Few are brave enough to stand up to tyranny. 幾乎沒有人能夠敢地對暴政。 Soldiers, stand down! 士兵們，退下！ back up/back down back up 當動詞時，意思是「支持某人」，是種與你共同進退的承諾；而當名詞時要記得把空格去掉，寫成“backup”，指的是「支援、援軍」或是「備用的」。 back down 則是指「放棄、打退堂鼓」。像是有部好萊塢動作片就叫做“Never back down”，中文譯作「永不退縮，呢！ Will you back me up? 你會幫我嗎？ The commander decided to back up the front line soldiers with more backup units. 指揮官決定用更多的後援部隊來支持前線的士兵。 It started raining cats and dogs in the middle of the hike. Since we had no backup plan, we had to head home early. 登山到一半的時候忽然下起了滂沱大雨，我們沒有其他備案，只好提早回家。 turn up/turn down turn up 可以指「把某事物調高」，例如調高音量或調高暖氣溫度；也可以指某人的「出現、到場」。 turn down 則是 turn up 的反義詞，指「把某事調低」，例如調低音量或調低暖氣溫度；或者指「拒絕」的意思。 The DJ turned up just in time, he then turned up the music.
